At A Glance

CHICAGO, Aug. 31 (AP)—Grain futures still were nervous today after yesterday's heading but managed to work upward a cent a bushel at times on commission house and commercial buying, and some short-covering.

TORONTO, Aug. 31 (CP)—Prices shifted over a narrow range and closed down today on the Stock Exchange, about even with Wednesday's level. Basic Metal Stocks had a small net gain, the golds a minor net loss and other groups held about even.

MONTREAL, Aug. 31 (CP)—Papers again led a generally firm market in quiet trading today on the Montreal Stock Exchange and Curb Market. The average for the group rose 2.16 to 171.79.

NEW YORK, Aug. 31 (AP)—Selected stocks in the peace classification again attracted modest bids today while many market leaders slipped a notch or did nothing.

LONDON, Aug. 31 (OP)—An early firm trend on the Stock Market today failed to hold as interest fell off and occasional profit-taking developed. British funds dipped slightly in the absence of investment support but rails held steady and some support appeared for leading oils. Some losses were registered over a fairly broad list of industrials.

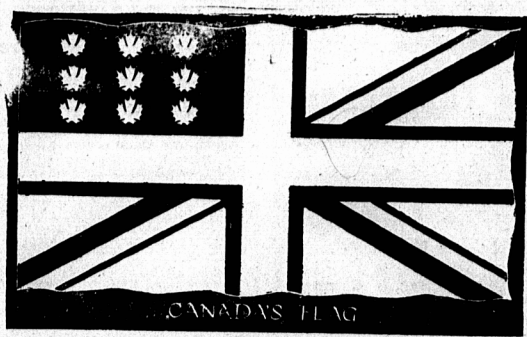
