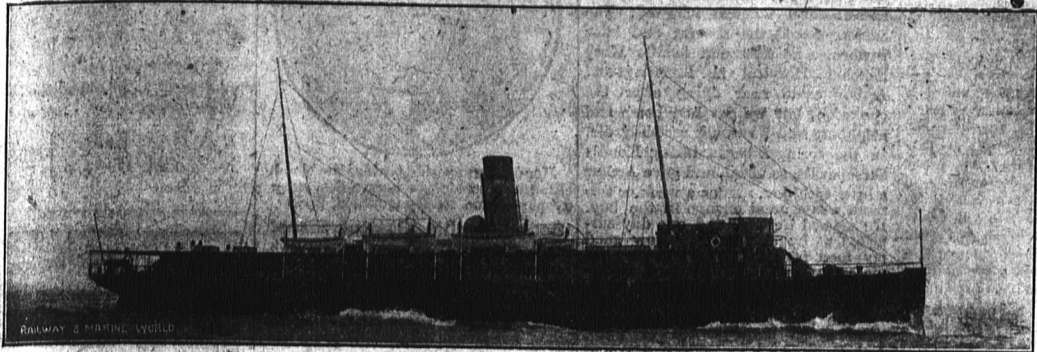

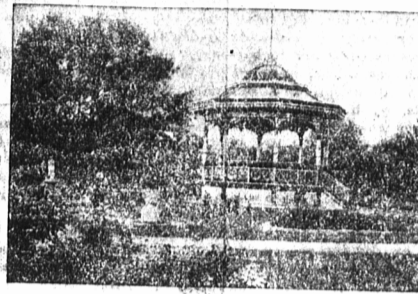

Authors' Curious Slips

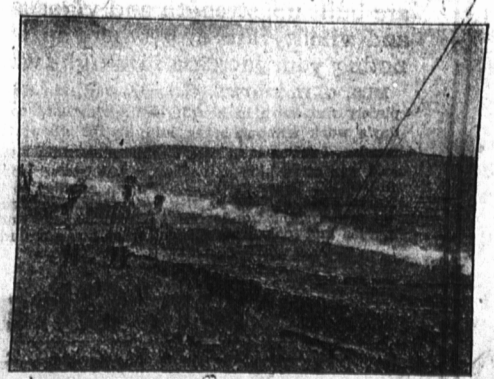

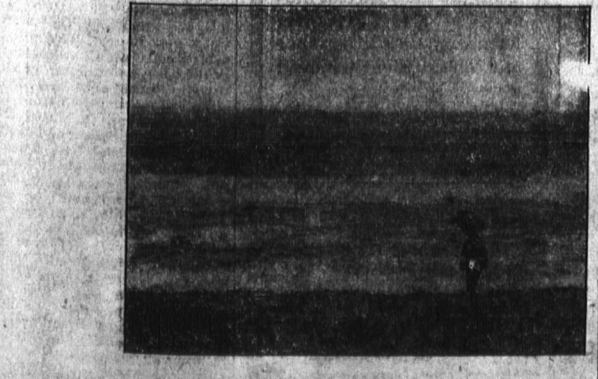
England, Mother England
