SPICES AND FLAVORINGS

An airtight canister is a saving container these days. It keeps in all the spices, coffee and other flavorings that would otherwise float away in the air use some of the screw jars and the metal containers that cookies and crackers used to come in. They seal tight and protect precious cooking ingredients which are scarce. Wash them thoroughly in suds to eliminate all previous odors, and, if possible, select ones that are similar in shape and graduated in size. If they are kept out where they will show, give them a touch of color so they will harmonize with the rest of the kitchen. A good quality, quick-drying enamel can be used in both glass and metal. Then paint an inch band of color around the bottom of each jar and around the edge of the top, and if you wish, add an easy-to-draw flower or vegetable design in the center or stick on a decal.

Kensington And Vicinity

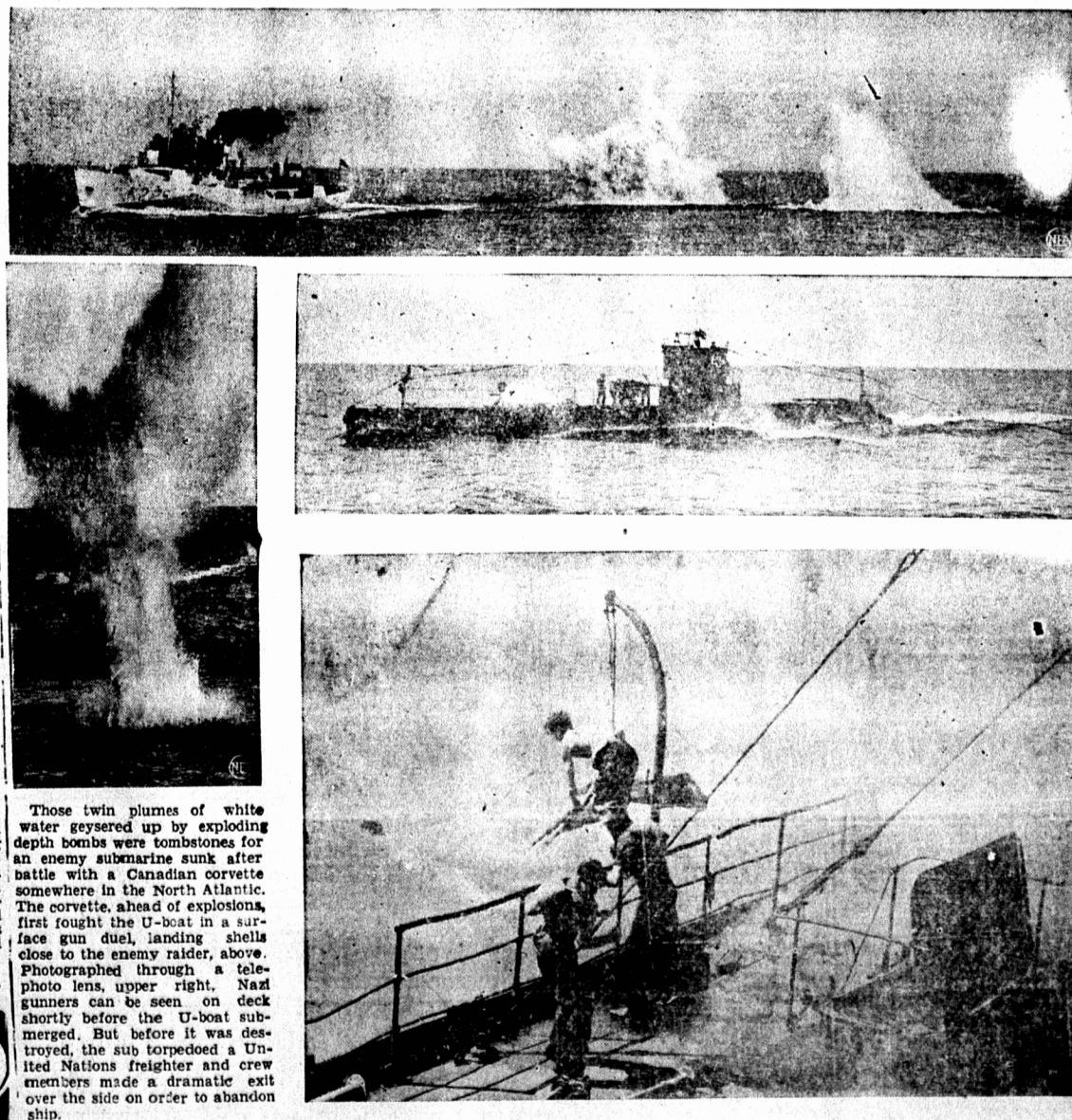
