Souris sport fans turned out five hundred strong at Souris Rink on Friday, February 27th, for a gala three-hour program featuring hockey, broom-ball, and races.

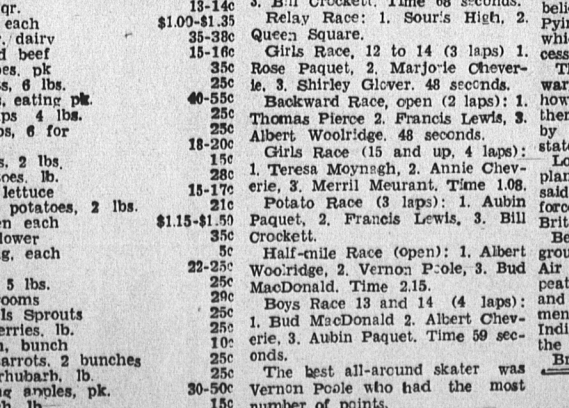
