5. The answers from this Local Club must be delivered to this office, and they will be collected at number of marks, run by members of The International Newspaper Study Club and the name cut by number only.

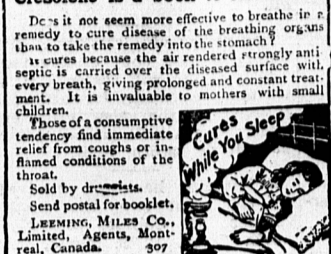
