CLASSES FOR BRIDES

From all over the world Hollanders have volunteered or were called up to fight for the liberation of the occupied Netherlands. Many of them while being in Canada or in England have married Canadian or English girls. After the war these girls expect to follow their Dutch husbands to Holland and already preparations are made in London to render this complete change in their lives as easy as possible. The Netherlands Government promoted that classes be organized to teach the young housewives the fundamentals of the Dutch language and—above all—the fundamentals of Dutch cooking. For in due time it may prove to be even more important if she can make her husband a good dish of "snert" (heavy green pea soup) or a stew called "Hutspot" (hutch-potch or carrots, potatoes and meat and onions), then to be able to call him "daring" or "honey" in Dutch or to ask, "Where have you been all this time?"

DUTCH SAY IT WITH FLOWERS

The Dutch are saying it with flowers, as shown in two reports recently received from occupied Holland.

Local papers in Rotterdam revealed that young gardeners had sown many pounds of flower seeds—mainly marguerites—in the rubble created by German bombings of that city in 1940. The seeds, provided

free by flower merchants, were planted in the spring of 1941 and are now blooming. The marguerite is a symbol of Dutch courage and patriotism. The latest Princess of the Netherlands Royal House, born in Ottawa January 13, was named "Margriet" after this flower.

BOYS' REINFORCED CLOTHING STILL PERMITTED

Small boys have a habit of sliding down bannisters and teen-agers enjoy climbing trees. To take care of the needs of growing boys, the Wartime Prices and Trade Board, while reminding them that they have a responsibility to conserve materials as well as the grown-ups, has made provision for reinforcements of their clothing.

The consumer Branch which has had many inquiries as to the way in which the regulations provide for the requirements of growing boys, points out that double seats are still permissible for small boys' trousers and two-pant suits for teen-age boys.

The clothing regulations ensure the continuance of manufacture of double seats on boys' breeches and long pants from 6 to 16 years of age. Two pairs of trousers may be made for boys, aged 12 to 16, in sizes 30 to 34, in either one or two of the following styles, long, breech and short.

Readers who have intelligent question to ask on price control are invited to send them in writing to the Women's Regional Advisory Committee of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board.
Q. I would like to buy some hand tools for my farm. May I buy them without a permit?
A. Yes. Hand tools, however, do not include any kind of pump.
Q. I am being married this summer and am having two bridesmaids. May they wear long gowns?
A. No. The bride may wear a long wedding gown, provided it is white or cream, attendants must wear short afternoon dresses.
Q. Do we farmers get extra sugar for feeding men who help with threshing?
A. Provision was made last year to allow extra sugar for this purpose. It is now under consideration by the Board. An announcement regarding this is expected shortly.

THE COOK'S CORNER

BANNOCK

Have a good fire going before you mix the dough.
Two cups flour (cake flour is best, but on a trip all purpose flour is most practical because it may be used for all flour purposes), 4 teaspoons baking powder, 1-2 teaspoon salt, 2 or 3 tablespoons shortening, 3-4 cup milk or water (approximately). Mix the flour, baking powder and salt in a paper bag and shake it well. (This has to do because you can't carry a sifter in your hip pocket!)
If instead of liquid milk you use powdered milk mix it with the dry ingredients. The shortening is added next. Chop it up with a knife into fine pieces, then finish by rubbing between fingers and thumb until no lumps remain. With a spoon stir in the water or milk, a little at a time add just enough to make the dough all stick together. Flour your frying pan, and spread the dough on it. Hold the pan above the flames for 2 minutes to brown the bottom of the bannock. Then prop the pan at a 45 degree angle (the bannock will not fall out) where it will receive reflected heat. A few glowing coals may be raked out and placed under the pan. Every few minutes
