 LESSON IV. JULY 28.
 THE WHEAT AND THE TARES.
 Matt. 13: 24-30, 36-43.

GOLDEN TEXT.
 "Gather up first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them; but gather the wheat into my barn."
 —Matt. 13:30.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.
 By Rev. D. W. Snider

The parables of the Sower and of the Drag-net as well as that of the Wheat and the Tares (our lesson for today) make one thing plain, and that is that there are disappointing and unsatisfactory things which are to be endured upon the part of those who look for ideal condition and unqualified perfection in the growth and development of the Kingdom of God. One must be content to have his ideal shattered.

Moral conditions which are faulty and wrong prevent, in the first place, the seed of the kingdom from the wheat or to feel an itching and clever desire to root them from the wheat, but that it is another thing to esteem it our business to do so. There are places, and this is one, where a word to the wise is sufficient, and that word is, "Hands off."

Yet Jesus Christ does not love the tares which His enemy has sown any more than His despondent disciple who mourns over such a state of affairs but it is evident that the Master is more careful of the wheat. Not for anything will He have the good grain uprooted. A momentous lesson lies right here: What a bad boy in a class might be told for his reformation may be the suggestion of an uprooting evil to the purblind and innocent boy at his side. The time of sure distinction and of final separation will come. Make no mistake about that. The caviller at the faults and failings and hypocrisies which he discerns in the household of God will come to the harvest time, let him not doubt. In like manner, the saint of God who has permitted himself to look morbidly upon the things he would not see and that God will not carry into His barn—let him not forget that there shall surely be harvest and a winnowing in both all-wise and safe-judging hands.

He—the Judge—shall be the Son of Man. That means the Son of no land but of all lands—the Son of no age or era, but of all ages and eras, the Son of Man will make no mistake in His judgment of either or of both.

What appears like success at one time history reads out as sickening chagrin and defeat at another time. The tares may have their day of toiling splendor in the waving world-field wherein the kingdom of God is found, but their day is coming when they shall be gripped by the binders for the burning. "Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father."

There need be no surprise at what envy or revenge will attempt or what for the time being they appear able to accomplish. Be surprised, however, into the shame of deep repentance at that moment we forget that God knows or that He cares, or that the kingdom given to His Son shall fall. Sleepless rush and haste are not becoming to the children of God. Working while it is day is. Trusting through the night is. The devil may work by night while the saints trust fully sleeps, but forget not what the Lord hath spoken as it is found in the lesson text at verses 41-43.
