It must be remembered that the pride of Germany's army here out-numbered the Canadians who were untrained, un-equipped and short of ammunition and food—their only food being corned beef, biscuits and black tea. Steel helmets were unknown up to this date. Hand grenades were made from empty jam cans filled with bits of iron and powder but at this they stemmed the tide.

And it is hard to figure what would have happened if the German army at that time had continued to march through to the Coast. She would have had control of the English Channel which would have perhaps made a vast difference in the way the end of the War came.

French's dispatch: We learn tonight that the capture of Hill 60, the commanding height to the south east of Ypres was a most important success, as it is the key to the situation hereabouts.

"April 21: The German attempts to retake Hill 60 still continue but with as little success as before."

CANADIANS AT YPRES (By Major D. A. MacDonald) From my diary and collections I contribute in loyal memory of Comrades who took part in the second battle of Ypres 17 years ago today, April 22nd, 1915.

The mist of time is growing dense, perhaps it is well in many cases but the memory of Ypres and its surrounding villages will always remain bright and unforgettable by some of us.

April 22nd dawned a beautiful sunny day. Canadians were billeted in and about this noted City of Ypres. Little was thought that before another day her inhabitants would have been driven with terror from their homes. Early in the afternoon shells began to drop in and about the city and continued increasingly until Ypres was a mass of ruin.
