What was Haliburton's place in American literature? Ray Palmer Baker, Ph.D. in his critical estimate introductory to the volume of the Nova Scotian author's works says:

"Shortly before his death W. D. Howells remarked that Thomas Chandler Haliburton had dominated for three generations the humorists of the United States; and though this estimate may be erroneous, there can be little doubt about his influence on the writers of America."

By birth and education Haliburton was a gentleman and a scholar, yet no writer of his day or since so well understood the common people of his time in both the Maritime Provinces and New England...
