TORONTO, Oct. 27.—A new experience and with it a real thrill for H. R. H. Prince Nicholas, of Roumania, when today he rode the engine of the powerful locomotive of the Canadian National Railways drawing the special train bearing Her Majesty Queen Marie and his sister H. R. H. Princess Ileana. Prince Nicholas has a taste for matters mechanical and with it a desire to further his knowledge of the methods of doing things in industry and in transportation. H. R. H. had greatly desired to spend some time in the power plants at Niagara Falls but the limited time at the disposal of the Royal Party prevented a visit of extended character. When the special train was running through the Niagara Peninsula Her Majesty expressed the wish that the Prince could make a complete survey of such matters and added that a ride on a locomotive would have an educational value. It was explained that this could be arranged, and according a stop was made at Port Credit and Prince Nicholas went forward and boarded the cab, taking the seat on the driver's side accompanied by Mr. R. H. Fish, general superintendent of the Toronto division. Prince Nicholas asked if questions were in order and being assured that they were made inquiries regarding the mechanism, displaying a keen interest in all aspects of locomotion. At Toronto H. R.
