A SPLENDID CONCERT AT MT. ALLISON.

SACKVILLE, May 1—On Friday evening the Misses Hannah Gertrude Clarke (Newcastle N. B.), and Alice Maud Melanson (Joggins's Mines, N. S.), pianists, and Mary Louise Evans, reader (Port Hawkesbury, N. S.), gave one of the very best recitals which have been given during this spring's most successful series of graduating recitals. The graduates were assisted by Miss Rita Brennan of St. John, N. B., who sang several songs most sweetly and delicately. Miss Clarke and Miss Melanson gave their piano numbers in excellent and characteristic style. Their program included numbers by Beethoven, Chopin, Mendelssohn, Bach, Schubert, Liszt and others. Perhaps special mention should be made of Miss Clarke's Reverie and Schubert-Liszt number and of Miss Melanson's "Cascade" by Pauer and Beethoven Sonata. These were executed with great brilliance and precision. Probably everyone is attracted by the appearance of a reader on a program and on Friday evening Miss Evans well repaid those who came to listen to her. During her first reading, "Sergius and the Lion," which is a particularly heavy and lengthy selection, Miss Evans proved her ability to render this style of reading by sustaining the attention of her listeners throughout every detail of the number. In her "Story of a Life" Miss Evans called out the sympathies of her audience with the pathos of the life of Zette, the little street arab. She has the splendid power of making very vivid to the listener the setting of her stories. "The Angelus" was given last and was unanimously declared to be the very best of all Miss Evans's delightful program. Miss Evans has a charming appearance when interested in her interpretation of a story and displays fine breath control. Altogether she scored a great success with her entire recital and is to be highly congratulated upon her work which was so thoroughly artistic and genuine throughout. Much credit reflects upon Miss Mitchell, head of the Oratory Department and upon Professor Horsfall, Director of the Conservatory, on the very excellent concert which was given on Friday to those who were privileged to attend.

DAMAGES AGAINST LICENSE INSPECTOR IN "INTERDICT" CASE.

TORONTO, May 3—William Piggott was awarded \$100 damages against Thomas French, license inspector of Kent County, today. Piggott claimed that French placed his name on the "interdict list" without proper authority, and sued for \$2,000 damages. In his defence French claimed that Charles McKnight, a brother-in-law of the plaintiff, wrote to him, stating that Piggott was "addicted to strong drink in excess." Chancellor Boyd pronounced it a serious matter to stigmatize a man as being addicted to the use of liquor in excess, to put this in writing, and publish it among houses of entertainment, as an act of a public officer. It was held that there was not sufficient reason for putting Piggott on the list.
