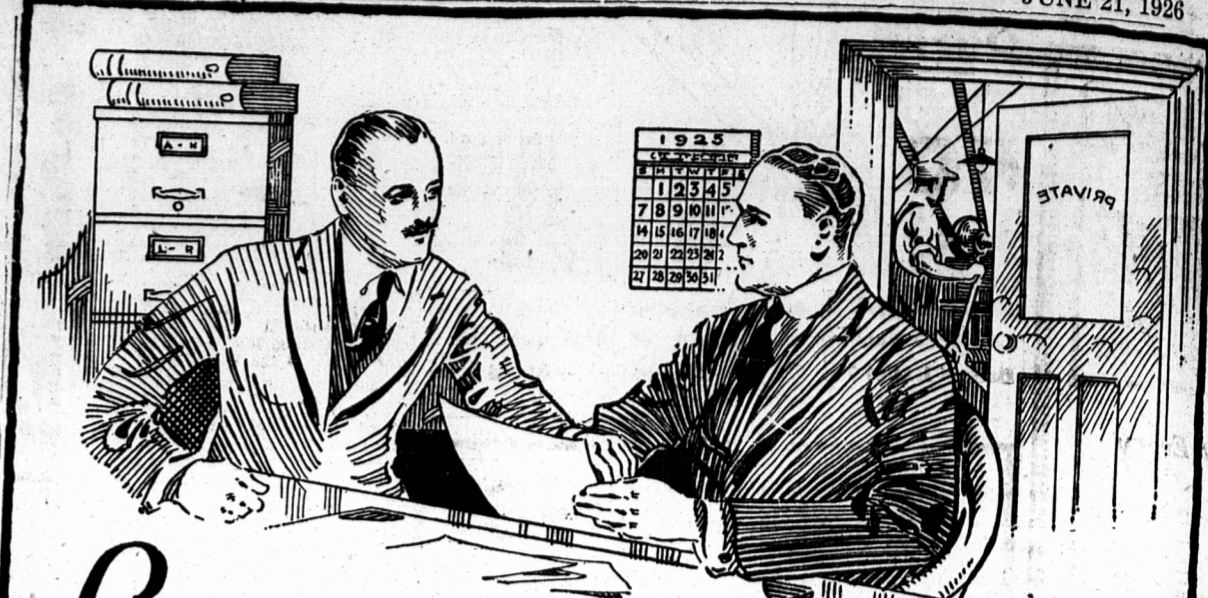

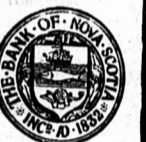

COMPETITORS

Canada is now pitted against the rest of the world in the market of our greatest commodity, the province of Saskatchewan probably stands first, both on an of its great area and the progress it has made within the past few years in mixed agricultural production.

According to a statement in a recent issue of The Financial Post, Saskatchewan derived last year from its dairy production alone \$21,348,000, as compared with \$17,566,000 production of the year 1924.

The total live farm stock last year was valued at \$134,608,000. Last year's total revenue from farm products amounted to \$480,000,000.

This is a rapid pace for the Maritimes to keep up with, and Saskatchewan, although the largest province, is not the whole West and the other provinces are making good progress.

In the world's markets, where East and West must meet, two things are necessary, quality and quantity. While quality comes first, it is of little use unless there is a sufficient quantity of it to make an impression on the market.

Prince Edward Island's dairy business has made good progress, both in quality and quantity, in the past decade. It has a long way to go yet before it reaches its possible maximum in quantity.

In cheese also we have kept well to the front. Now with the whole province a certified disease-free area we have an opportunity to forge ahead.

Dairying pays. Even with our long period of winter-feeding, as compared with the outdoor feeding of the Western provinces, dairying pays here and the more we have of it the better it pays.

The King Government has won two victories within the past few days, by a "majority of the members of the House."

Men and women die because they are powerless to prevent it, not for the sake of getting a flattering obituary.

Something of this kind has been going on for some time in Canada. There has been an industrial epidemic in Canada, one which has affected thousands of workmen.

They are getting away from the infected area, not for the sake of "fulsome praise" on their departure, or when they make good elsewhere, but to make a living for themselves and their families.

Everyone in the House, and in the country as well, knew that Mr. Kennedy, the member for Peace River, had been elected by ballot.

The Premier and his Ministerial colleagues do not have the respect of those who support them in Parliament. Their Liberal supporters have perhaps some decent respect for the old-time leadership of MacKenzie, Blake and Laurier and the record those leaders left behind them.

It may be asked why then do otherwise respectable Liberals in Parliament support the present Government, seeing they can have no respect for it?

The aggregation may thus prolong its hold upon office until the end of the parliamentary term, three or four years hence, for this "majority of members" may be depended upon to hold on to their jobs to the last man and the last dollar.
