Farm Laborers For The West

Canadian National Railways Will Give Reduced Fares and Special Train Service on August 13th.

Investors are urgently needed in the West to garner in the wheat yield of Canada.

Investments are that over 300,000 bushels of wheat stand ready for reaping. This is addition to other grains.

The call of the West is for 30,000 Farm Laborers to harvest this immense grain crop. Canada's prosperity depends on the response.

The Canadian National Railways is prepared for the transport of Harvesters from all parts of the System From Maritime Province points special arrangements have been made. Reduced fares to Winnipeg are to be granted on August 13th and special trains will run via Quebec Bridge and from Quebec to Winnipeg via the Transcontinental Line as the best and quickest route from Maritime Province points. The trains will be furnished by Ticket Agents when the best type of new colonist ticket is purchased enabling holders to secure return ticket at reduced rate.
