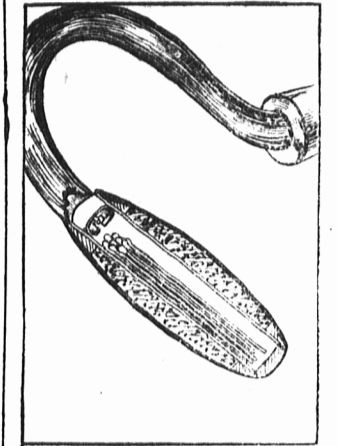

MATCH BOX IN THE HANDLE BAR.

The recent resuscitation of the bicycle boom has had the effect of bringing out a new lot of inventions for the purpose of affording minor conveniences to the man behind the handle bars. One of them is pictured herewith in a match box which is secreted within the grips of the bicycle. The fellow who makes a practice of riding at night is liable to want matches at any minute, and it often happens that, like the virgins of the Bible, he does not discover that he is not prepared until his light goes out and at some spot where it is next to impossible to get a light.
