THE ELECTION LAW.

The proposed amendments to the election law do not include the ballot. This we regard as a grave defect.

But while rejecting so necessary an improvement as the ballot, endorsed by the entire civilized world, the bill directly attacks the vital principle of the independence of parliament by opening the gate for the admission of salaried office holders.

Put this is not the class for whose relief the notorious clause is introduced. It is for that class who do value the office and the salary, and who value them so highly that they would not resign even if solicited to do so in order to be elected.

The proposal to admit postmasters to the Legislature is in every way a bad innovation. It is the opening of a door which ought to be kept locked and closed.

Federal office holders are a legion in the land. It is quite possible, and even probable, that once admitted to the floor of the House there would be a time when enough of them there to decide the fate of the Government of the day.

We have many matters and claims yet to be adjusted with Ottawa, and we want a free hand, a fair field in settling these claims and controversies.

a time is in the independence of our Government and Legislature. It is a good time to beware of the Greeks giving gifts." If we admit federal officials and employees to our Legislature we may be sure that these men will always have an eye to the power that appoints, employs and pays them.

It is in no unfriendly spirit that we set forth these objections. We would sincerely regret to see the new Government under Premier Hazard, now beginning its work under fair auspices, commit so grave and impolitic a blunder as to pass this obnoxious clause.

Hon. George E. Foster has fallen from grace in regard to prohibition of which he was once the earnest and eloquent advocate. 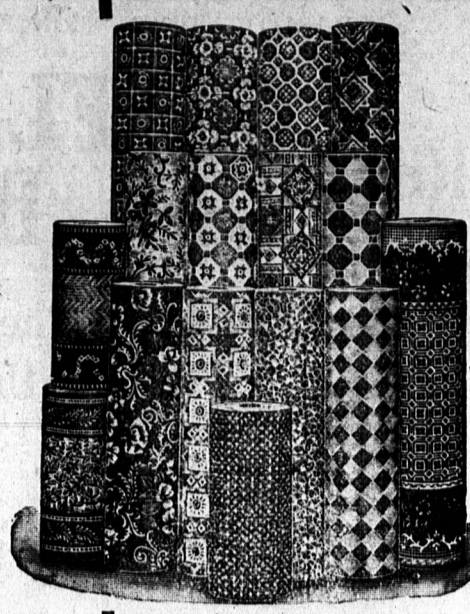
