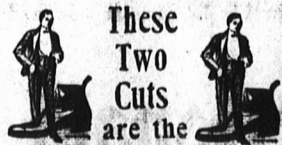

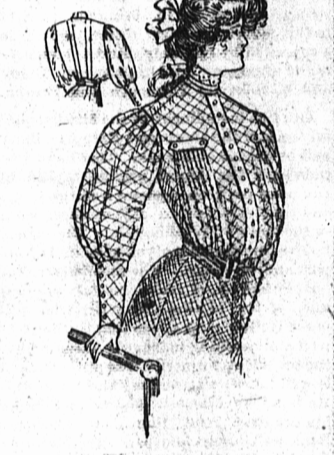

MISSE'S SHIRT WAIST.
No. 3133.

The shirt waist continues to hold its own as prime favorite, and a pretty linen waist, such as shown in the illustration, is desirable to have ready for warm days. The waist fronts have the fullness of blouse and bust cleverly introduced by means of tucked sections, which in this costume was made of heavy English eyelet embroidery or linen. A neat strap, held in place by buttons emphasizes the elaboration. The sleeves are of the newest type, forming large puffs from shoulder to elbow, where they are gathered in a deep gauntlet cuff.

It is an excellent pattern for remodeling plain waists as the tucked sections in front and centre portion of back, which is tucked to simulate a graduated double box plait, may be made of a contrasting fabric.

A lining is supplied which may be omitted. It is a most effective design for pique or white or colored duck, lawn, taffeta, foulard, mohair, fine serge, cashmere, nun's veiling, or albatross.

The waist pattern (No. 3133) is cut in sizes for 12, 14 and 16 years, and requires 3 yards of 36-inch material, with 2 yards of lining, for the 14-year size.

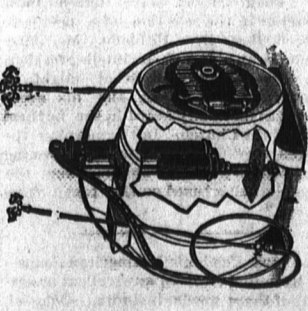
