SCOTLAND BIRTH RATE ESTIMATES

(Canadian Press.)
LONDON, April 11.—(Gazette Cable.) The report of the Registrar General of Scotland for 1911, which was issued unusually late, shows the birthrate to be 2,965 per 1,000 estimated population, which is the lowest rate ever recorded although 1,200 more than a corresponding rate from England and Wales. The percentage of illegitimate births is the highest since 1901.
