SAVE THE FINGERS

Dissolving Old Rubber

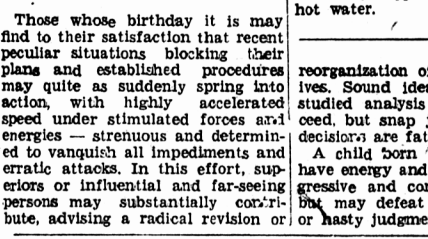

STEAMED CARROT PUDDING

- 1/2 cup mild-flavoured fat 1 cup brown sugar 1 egg 1 cup grated potato 1 cup grated carrot 1 1/2 cups raisins 1 cup currants 1/2 cup mixed peel, chopped 1 1/2 cups all-purpose or 1 1/2 cups pastry flour 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon 1/2 teaspoon cloves 1 teaspoon soda 2 tablespoons water Cream fat and sugar thoroughly. Add beaten egg, then potatoes, carrots and fruit. Mix and sift flour, salt and spices and add to first mixture alternately with water in which soda has been dissolved. Blend well. Turn into greased moulds, filling them two thirds full and steam steadily for 3 hours. 12 servings. Note: If currants are not available, increase the amount of raisins used.
