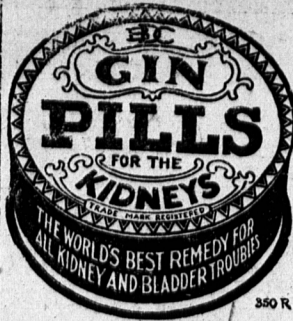

**RECORD FOR
MONTREAL PORT**

MONTREAL, Dec. 14.—A new re-
cord is created for the Port of
Montreal by the arrival here today
by the George W. Clyde from
Philadelphia, making a longer sea-
son of navigation for the port for
the year 1921 than any other in its
history. When the first steamer
docked here this year on March 27,
it constituted the earliest opening
of the port for seventy years and
today's arrival makes the duration
of the present season eight and a
half months. The vessel experi-
enced little or no difficulty in as-
cending the River St. Lawrence,
but special precautions were taken
to keep the Lachine canal open
for the first leg of her inland voy-
age to Chicago.
