**P.E. ISLAND EGGS WIN SECOND AWARDS**  
High honours for the Prince Edward Island Egg Circles at the Canadian National Exhibition, Toronto.  
Word was received on Saturday that the Prince Edward Island Co-operative Egg and Poultry Association had secured two second awards in the Commercial section of the Egg exhibit at the Canadian National Exhibition, being held in Toronto.  
The Association came second in extras, and number ones, the next grade below the extras; missing taking first place in each case by only one point. The competition was extremely keen and more than two hundred cases of eggs were in competition.  
In extras the Association gained the highest possible number of points for uniformity and style of packing and only missed taking first place due to a slight shrinkage undoubtedly due to the long distance that the eggs had to travel. Regarding the lower grade the Island Circles practically tied with the Dundas County, Ontario Egg Circles; the Judges after much deliberation finally awarding first honours to the Dundas County, Ontario Egg Circles on the only point which remained; namely, The bloom on the eggs, and this point had to be decided by taking the eggs out into strong daylight.  
Prince Edward Island farmers and especially Egg Circle Members may justly pride themselves, upon such a measure of success, having been achieved at the World's greatest Annual Exhibition. **ALLIED AEROPLANES DID GREAT DAMAGE TO GERMAN TOWNS**  
BASEL, Switzerland, Sept. 7, via Paris, Sept. 7.—The aerial bombardment of Saarbruecken, recorded in yesterday's official statement from the French War Office, was probably the most notable operation of its kind during the war. Forty French and British war aeroplanes circled low over the town and accurately threw bombs on the small arms factory, the barracks, the railway station, the engine sheds, and other military buildings. Several hundred yards of the permanent way of the railroads was destroyed, and many recruits in the barracks were killed or wounded.  
Saarbruecken is not provided with artillery for high angle fire, and an armored train had been summoned from Metz, bringing aerial guns on trucks, arrived too late to interfere with the operations of the aviators.  
All forty aeroplanes, after discharging about 400 projectiles returned safely to Nancy.
