EXPRESS RATES MUCH REDUCED

Voluntary Cut of American Companies Will Not Stop Investigation

WASHINGTON, July 3.—A sweeping investigation of all the express companies in the United States is being conducted by the Interstate Commerce Commission.

Evidently in anticipation of this action by the commission, practically all of the express companies with the exception of the Long Island, late yesterday afternoon, filed new tariffs which are believed to be material reductions in rates.

In its order today the commission says the complaints have been made against the express companies, that their rates, classifications, etc., are in violation of the interstate commerce act.

The reduction in express rates filed yesterday are said to be important only so far as they are known to be a combination of rates—that is instances in which shipments are made by two companies to a final destination.

The commission was taken by surprise yesterday afternoon when bulky packages were delivered containing the new tariffs. The new rates were dumped in on the commission only a short time before the closing hour.

The following instances illustrating the charge is cited: Under the system now prevailing in a haul between certain points where the rate is \$1.25 per hundred pounds, and two companies are participating, each company will charge fifty cents on a package of ten pounds, with proportionate graduating charges from one up to one hundred pounds.

The question of establishing a parcel post has come up again and is being actively promoted before the office committee of the house. In addition to the agitation for the parcel post, Democrats have been stirring up the subject of the express companies.

WOMAN RIGHT TO CHANGE MIND

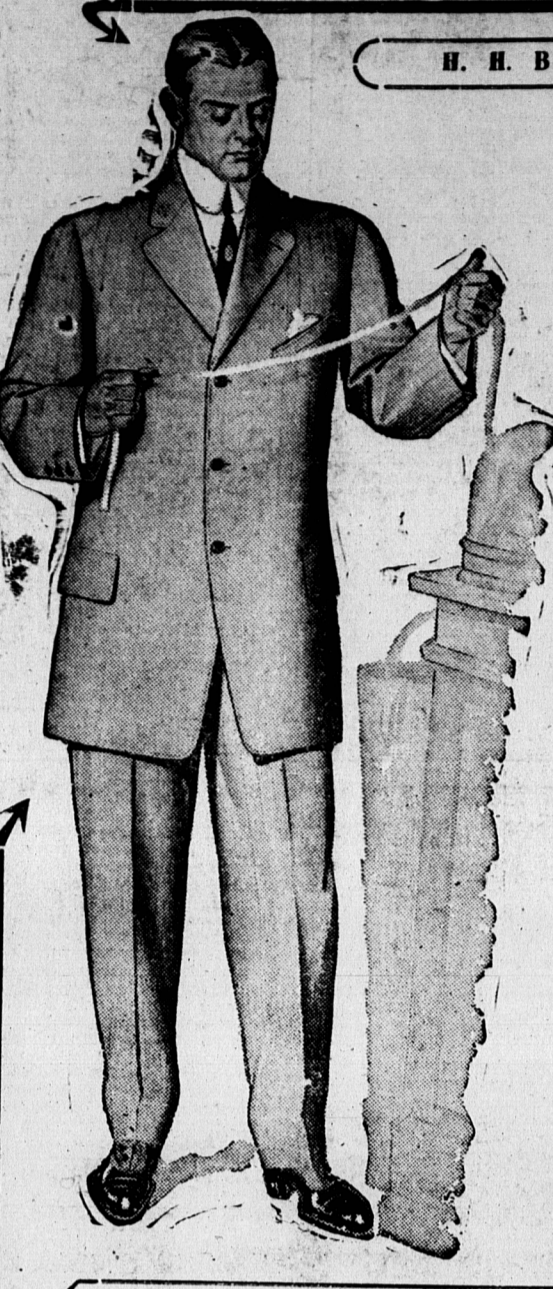

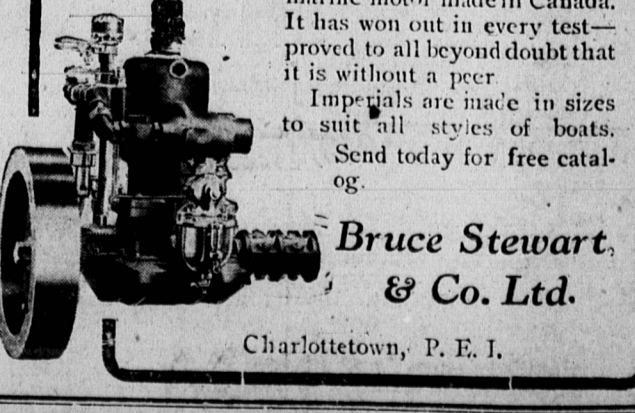
