TIMELY NOTES ON TOPICS CONNECTED WITH Silver Fox and Mink Farming

The Prize List for the 18th Live Fox Show and first Live Mink Show which will be held at the Exhibition grounds, Charlottetown, November 15-18 has been issued and should be in the hands of a great many exhibitors now. If you have not received your copy and are interested, just drop a postcard to Walter R. Shaw, Department of Agriculture, Charlottetown, and one will be mailed you.

The fox classes are much the same as previous years, namely, medium silver, light silver, extra light silver heavy veiled, and extra light, with silverings running to 74% for medium silver up to 89% for light silver and up to 100% for extra light silver. Standard white marked has only one class this year—extra light with up to 100% silver. Standard platinum has medium, light and extra light classes, dark median having been cut out. In the standard pearl platinum the medium class has been cut out but there are classes for light and extra light. All classes are divided into sections for adult males, adult females, pup males and pup females. After the various classes have been judged the winners will be brought together to compete for the championships such as champion standard silver adult, champion standard silver pup and grand champion standard silver. Similarly there will be champion marked silver adult, champion marked silver pup and grand champion marked silver. The same will apply to platinum. There will also be awards for get of sire and progeny of dam. Aggregate score trophies will be awarded, one for the standard silver classes and one for the new type classes.

The mink show will be the first ever held in this Province and is bound to be of interest not only to mink breeders but to fox breeders as well. Quite a number of our foremost fox breeders purchased standard and mutation mink last season from some of the best breeders in the United States and Canada. Locally the largest ranchers of mink are Stewart & Boop, whose ranch is just a few hundred yards from the Exhibition grounds at Charlottetown. These men have invested a great deal of money in the best types of mink procurable and they have been successful in raising a large number of progeny the past two years from the original stock or selection from it. Another very successful silver fox breeder and showman is Lowell W. Hancock of Summerside, who dropped some of his other business enterprises
