"No man wants to be standing up at the City Building getting relief when with a little bit of work he could get decent food to eat," the speaker said. Conditions were never worse in this Province, in his opinion.

Proposed Projects Outlined Mayor Foster in an address outlined a list of proposed projects with which the City Council approached the local government.

Waterfront Project Taken Up Hon. T. W. L. Prowse, in a short address, said the waterfront project had been taken up with Hon. Mr. Dunning but there had been no action as yet.

Represented Business Men Mr. J. O. Hyndman, called on by the chairman as a representative of the business men, told the meeting he had always been a Conservative but that he had told Mr. MacMillan the amount of relief this Province was getting was outrageous, and had gone even so far as to tell him he had better resign.

Other Speakers The meeting was then left open to other speakers. Mr. H. K. S. Hemming spoke briefly. There has been unemployment in this Province for 40 years or longer, he declared. Until the last few years however, young people estimated at 65,000 in number, had left and gone to all parts of the continent.

Test of Resolution Following was the text of the resolution passed: Resolved, whereas employment conditions in Charlottetown are more serious in present than at any other time since the depression set in, and whereas some movement must be immediately made to overcome the distress and destitution now prevalent in the homes of the wage earners, therefore, it is resolved that this meeting strongly advocate the immediate commencement of ordinary working projects, and to employ as many men as possible, and to continue to issue relief until such time as larger projects, already mentioned, can be got under way, and further resolved that the Municipal, Provincial and Federal representatives urge upon the Dominion Government to have those large projects started as soon as possible.

Believed To Have Been Used In First Survey Of This Province. A surveyor's compass, believed to have been used in the first surveys of Prince Edward Island, has been presented to the provincial Government by F. Carman Wrightman, consulting engineer and Nova Scotia land surveyor of Kentville, N. S.

The interesting souvenir includes a large compass, tripod and carrying case. Although of good old age the compass is in good condition and the tripod, which is in three sections, when folded resembles a telescope.

"This old land surveyor's compass has been in the possession of the writer for about 25 years. It was acquired while I was teaching school at Murray River, P. E. I. The Rev. J. A. McNeill, then resident at Murray River, secured it from an old gentleman of his acquaintance for me and told me that it had been used on the first surveys of the Island. The fact did not at the time interest me and only a few years ago did I notice the manufacturer's name pasted on the lid of the instrument case.

"Accordingly I have pleasure in presenting the instrument to the Government with the hope that it will be fittingly preserved and be of interest to any who may incline that way."
