Aviator Is Fined \$500

(Canadian Press) BOSTON, Mass., April 13—A fine of \$500 has been charged against Bert Balchen, trans Atlantic aviator, for violation of the customs regulations at this port, Wilfred W. Lufkin, Collector of Customs, said today. The fine resulted from an unauthorized landing at the east Boston airport several weeks ago by Balchen on his return from a flight to Newfoundland in search of survivors of the explosion of the sealing ship Viking. Lufkin said that Boston was not a port of entry for aeroplanes and that landings could not be made here without permission from the Treasury Department at Washington. Balchen has been notified of the Customs Department action, Lufkin said, and has been instructed concerning the procedure to obtain a remittance of the \$500. He must submit a remittance petition explaining the circumstances and this, with the recommendation of the Collector of the port, will be forwarded to Washington for disposition by the Secretary of the Treasury. In most past instances, Lufkin said, the fines have been remitted.
