Scrap Of Paper May Give Clue

PARIS, Oct. 24.—The criminal who attempted to assassinate Myron T. Herrick, the United States Ambassador, and wreck in the Embassy, may be tracked down by means of a scrap of paper in which he bears a few words of an address. The police, who are convinced that the outrage is the work of an individual, and not the result of an organized plot, hope to get a clue by comparing the handwriting with those of two or three hundred letters received at the Embassy recently, protesting against the death sentences imposed upon Zacco and Vanetti in New Jersey.

All of these letters are now in the hands of the police. Most of them are couched in moderate language and came from various Socialist organizations. Only one actually threatened the Ambassador with violence and that one was anonymous.
