AMERICAN REPORT ANCIENT TEMPLE FOUND NEAR ROME

(Canadian Press.)
BOSTON, Sept. 23.—(Special).—The American report of the Boston and Maine railroad for the year ending June 30, 1913, shows a deficit of \$1,324,441. This information was conveyed to the interstate commerce commission and public service commissions of Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, and Massachusetts, by Edgar J. Rich, general solicitor of the road at the hearing of the proposed increase rates today. The report which was not approved shows the gross operation revenue for the year to be \$48,513,597, operating expense \$38,101,424, leaving a net operating revenue of \$10,412,172, with outside revenue a total net revenue of \$10,509,996. The total deduction for rentals and other fixed charges amounted to \$9,880,899, dividends paid April 1st, \$1,374,238.

Taking the dividends and fixed charges from the gross corporate income \$9,930,595 leaves a deficit of \$1,324,441.

SCOTCH WHALES DYING OUT
The ancient and famous whaling industry of Scotland is rapidly dying out; such is the unmistakable meaning of the return just published in the annual report of the Fishery Board of Scotland. It appeared that the total catch of whales in Scottish waters during 1912 was only 440, as compared with 693 in 1911. This represents a decline of 13 per cent. in a year. It is less than 40 per cent. Curiously, however, an altogether exceptional number of sperm whales were captured—18, as compared with nine of the previous year.

ROME, Sept. 24.—(Special).—Excavations in the subterranean galleries of the Hot Springs of Diocletian have just brought to light a mediaeval mill, and a little further on a temple to Mithra an Asiatic deity much in honor among the Roman slaves and soldiers.

The temple which has just been unearthed is probably the finest specimen of its kind in the world, being in a much better state of preservation than the one discovered at Ostia.

TARIFF DEBATE NOT YET ENDED

WASHINGTON Sept. 23.—Chairman Simmons of the joint congressional tariff conference committee informed the officials of the State Department today that he does not believe it necessary to supplement the tariff bill with any resolution designed to continue the existing trade relations with foreign countries.

The point raised by Secretary Bryan, subject to further conference today between Senator Simmons and Robert F. Rose, Departmental Foreign Trade Advisor, "I do not believe there is danger of foreign countries imposing tariff penalties against the United States or that there is any reason for such action," said Senator Simmons.

The State Department is at work today preparing a resolution such as the officials desire to have pass both houses of congress guaranteeing that the maximum penalties proposed by the new law would not be applied against countries until an opportunity is given for the negotiation of new treaties.

The conference today completed most of the administrative sections of the tariff bill. The Senate's amendment prohibiting attorneys taking customs cases on a contingent basis was agreed to.

The strong inquisitorial features of the house bill, which gave the government power to exclude merchandise when foreign manufacturers refused to disclose the cost of manufacture, were modified materially. The new form would give the executive authority to levy a penalty of an extra duty against goods manufacturers who show undue disinclination to disclose the manufacturing cost.

FECONDITY.

"The fifth generation of descendants from a single female oyster would make more than eight worlds as large as the earth, even if each female only laid one brood of eggs."

The above startling quotation from W. K. Brooks, a great American biologist, appears at first sight incredible. It is merely a matter of mathematical computation, however, and is fairly conservative. Brooks estimated the average number of eggs spawned by a single oyster to be 16,000,000. Other investigators have given higher figures. Assuming half of these to be females, the number of oysters in the fifth generation would be 8,000,000. A moment's attempt at imagining this inconceivable sum will show that Brooks' surprising statement is not far wide of the truth.

This marvellous fecundity of the oyster and other living things is a great natural force that man should turn to account. Its primal purpose is to balance the enormous mortality among the lower orders of organized beings. If man betters the chances of survival of useful animals and plants, propagation will immediately increase in response to the improved environment. It is as though in some great machine, one were to reduce the friction and devote the energy, previously devoted to overcoming it, to increasing the efficiency of the engine. As much force is liberated in any case, but, by wise regulation, a greater proportion may be profitably utilized.—P. M. B.
