THE LAST SUPPER.

Matt. 26: 17-30.

GOLDEN TEXT.

"This is my body, which is given for you; this do in remembrance of me."—Luke 22: 19.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.

There does not appear to be any doubt in the minds of the disciples as to what the intentions of Jesus will be with regard to passover which is at hand. He will observe and keep it, of course. No one ever caught the idea of neglecting any of the ordinances of God from the teaching or the example of Jesus Christ. It was His fixed principle to attend them, even as it is recorded that it was His "custom" to worship in the synagogue on the Sabbath day.

Some of the worthiest, and, in every way, the most valuable and thoroughly to be trusted members of the church are never known as belonging to the officiating. They are quiet, consistent and never-failing friends of the pastor. And he is able to tell his successor about them, saying to him, somewhat as Jesus said to His disciples about His trusted friend in Jerusalem: "Go to such a man. He will not fail you."

Jesus not only had knowledge of His secret disciple in Jerusalem, but He also had knowledge of a traitor among those who were regarded as His select followers and chosen champions. Official status cannot blot out heart-wickedness. It makes it all the more glaring and brings upon itself a punishment which is all the more terrible.

But what hardness of heart it is possible to attain unto under circumstances of the most sacred sort! Think of the privilege of daily companionship with Jesus, and at the same time carrying on negotiations with His enemies and becoming so brazen that it is possible to look Him in the face and repeat the question of shocked and aggrieved innocents, saying, "Lord, is it I?" Surely the heart of man is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked. But Jesus Christ unflinchingly knows the hypocrite and traitor.

Many things which are intended to work out evil and which measurably purpose result, notwithstanding, in producing untold advantage and rebounding good in after days. This fact, however, does not justify the intended evil in the slightest degree. It must needs be that offences come, but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh. Though the death of Jesus meant the bringing of salvation to men, those who caused His death never had the indictment lifted with which Peter charged them, saying, "Ye by the hand of lawless men did crucify and slay."

The sacrament of the Lord's Supper has no meaning except as it stands related to the need of sinful men, and assures them of the remission of their sins through the shedding of blood, of precious blood, even the blood of Jesus.

The sacrament of the Lord's Supper is not an ordinance for the observance of the holy unless their holiness is confessed to be the result of the purchase and cleansing of the blood of Jesus. The Lord's table is, in a sense most precious, the sinner's table.

But it is the sinner's sacrament. This must not be forgotten. The sinner whose sins are remitted, forgive because of the blood of the covenant, must understand that he becomes a party to the covenant, and a sworn party at that. It is the pledge and vow of faithful and holy allegiance to Jesus Christ and of loyal service in His name, even to the death.

Jesus Christ carries His part of the covenant with Him into the Father's kingdom. A finished work was wrought on Calvary for men, but not a finished service. He abides faithful. His covenant is completed when He "shall drink it new with us in the Father's kingdom."

"When they had sung an hymn." The singing of hymns is often a cheap expression of devotion. Nevertheless, the world has not knowledge of a higher, richer, purer, grander worship than the singing of hymns. Keep on singing.
