METHODISM AT HAMPTON, N. B.

A Brief Description of the Beginning of Methodism at Hampton—Portraits of Some of the Pastors and of the New Church.

The beginnings of Methodism at Hampton date back to the year 1871. By that time Methodist preaching was begun by the Rev. J. B. Hommes, who visited this section as pastor of the Upham circuit. For some years previous to this, service had been held at the Village, the courtesies of the Baptist denomination being accepted in the use of their building by the Methodist people; but at the time above mentioned the Station was taken up as an additional preaching appointment. First in the old Athenaeum and later in Barnes' Hall, services were conducted for several years. The ministers who will be remembered as having preached at the station in the early days are—

Revs. J. B. Hommes, S. B. Ackman, S. W. Sprague, Thos. Allen and Charles Comben.

In the fall of the year 1890 the movement was begun which resulted in the erection of the artistic building in which the Methodist congregation worship, unto this day. Some among the few who were then interested in Methodism and its mission felt that a forward movement should be made and something definite done in the way of establishing the Methodist cause in this place.
