"SIMPLE LIVING" 2,000 YEARS OLD

Searchers Find Health Treatises And Social Invitations Of Egyptians — They Lead The Simple Life

LONDON, March 19.—Dr. B. P. Grenfell has just returned from Egypt and made public some translations of the interesting papyri which Dr. Hunt and he discovered recently at the ruins of Oxyrhynchus. In the rubbish mounds there they found all sorts of documents in little worse condition than when they were thrown away. Among them were marriage contracts, invitations to dinner and weekly bills for cooking. One of these manuscripts, of which Dr. Grenfell supplies the date as the second century, runs:

Chairemon invites you to dine with him at the table of the Lord Serapis in the Serapeum to-morrow, which is the 15th of the month, at 9 o'clock (about 3 o'clock in the afternoon). Another translation runs: Herais invites you to dine with her at the marriage of her children in her house to-morrow, which is the 5th, at 9 o'clock. It will thus be seen that the phrasing of an invitation issued some 1800 years ago differed very little from the form used in modern times. A letter written between the second and third centuries by a boy of 14, to his father, who was going to Alexandria and could not take his son there to live with him, reads: "This is a fine thing—you not taking me to Alexandria, I won't write you a letter, or speak to you or say good-bye to you. . . . If you won't take me I won't eat, I won't think. There, now!

But these extraordinary finds contain nothing quite so remarkable as the irrefutable evidence that the simple life movement was advocated 2,000 years ago, and that to-day its disciples are only reflecting the sentiment of one of Pindar's odes, which at the hands of Dr. Grenfell and Dr. Hunt is now laid bare.

The manuscript was written for the people of Ceos, which was celebrated as the home of athletes and poets. The central idea of the poem is the virtue of contentment with a simple life like that of the Ceans in their rocky island. The papyrus runs:

Verily, though I live on a rock. I am known for prowess in Hellenic contests, and known for some display of the Muse's art; verily, too, my acres bear a measure of Bacchus' life-giving cure in extremity. I have not horses nor share in the pasturage of kine; but neither would Melampus leave his fatherland to lord it in Argos. The city and kindred of a man's home and his kinsmen are dear and bring contentment. In happiness remote from foolish men I praise the wise lord Euxantius who when his fellows were eager re-

fused to rule or to take the seventh share of a hundred cities along with the sons of Pasiphae, and he spake to them a prophecy:

"Then shall I, in pursuit of wealth and trusting aside into utter neglect the decree of the blessed ones of our country, have elsewhere a great possession? How would this be to secure to me? Dwell not, my heart, on the cypress grove, dwell not on the pastures of Ida! To me little is given, a mere shrub of cake, but I have no lot in trouble or strife."
