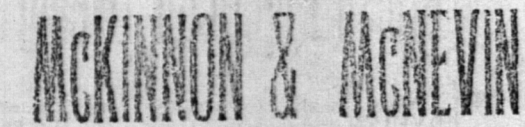

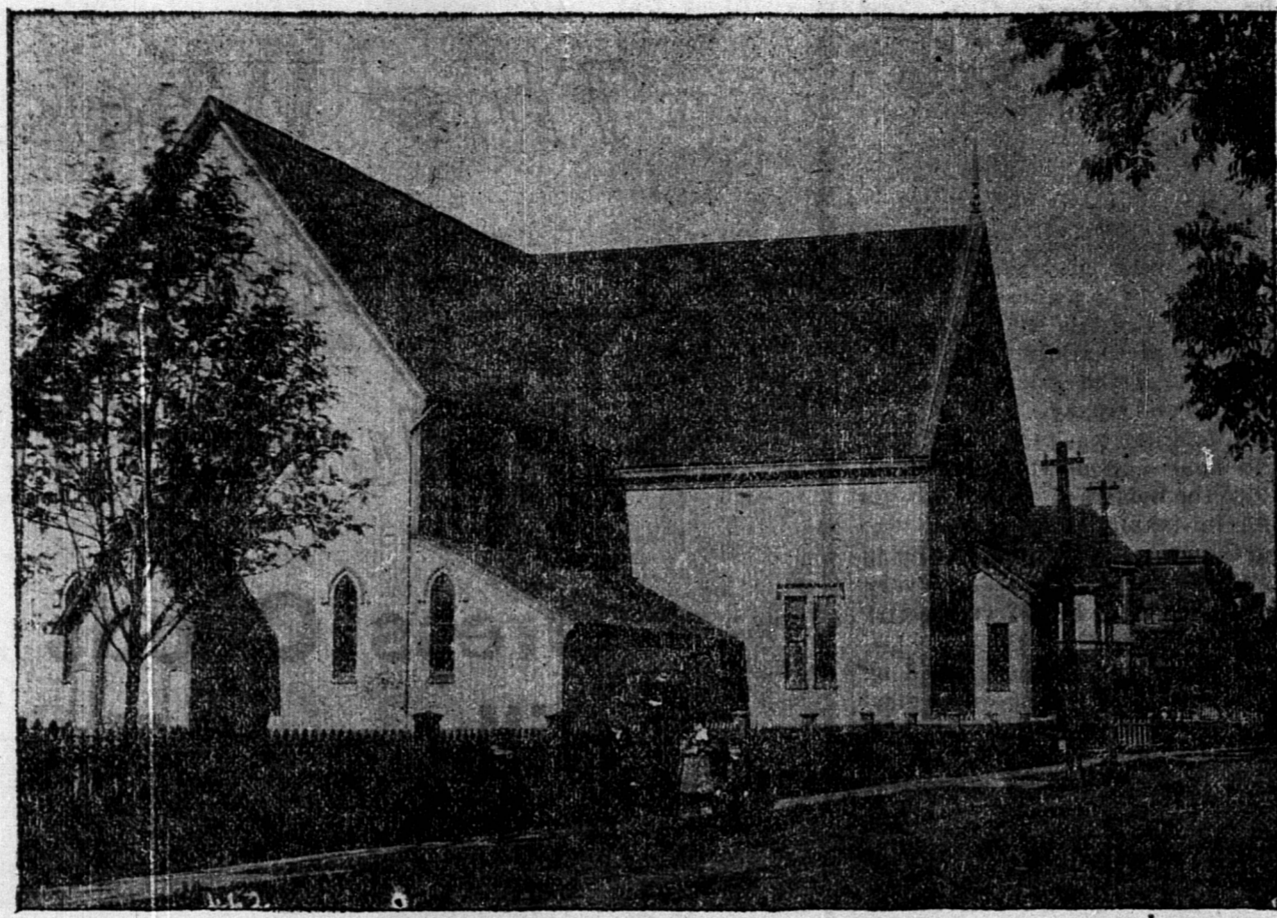
THE NEW ORGAN FOR GRACE CHURCH
