DISEASE AS AN ALLY.

A recent despatch from St. Petersburg tells that an epidemic of cholera and typhoid is threatening at Harbin, where the water supplies are polluted and the sanitary conditions are shockingly bad.

Indeed such has frequently occurred. In the war in South Africa enteric was more fatal than the deadly malarialism of the Boers. In the Crimea the French lost 236 from sickness to 64 from wounds in each thousand. The death rate of the British in the same war was 179 from sickness and 47 from wounds.
