I have travelled on the P. E. Island roads the greater part of my life and on the roads of this province for the past four years. I therefore claim a fair comparison between them.

Why, they said, "that is the system we had here 50 years ago." So your people are literally 50 years behind the times in their mode of winter travelling at least.

The tracks are always well beaten here, as driving either double or single, the horses walk in the runner tracks.

There are hardly any "sidelings" and "pitches" are not nearly so bad. The heavy hauling is done with double bob-sled here. They are very much better than the long sleighs often used at home with a single horse.
