Electric safety lamps are coming into very general use in British mines where there is any risk of explosion. One element in their safety is the fact that the minor cannot be extinguished by the minor current. A strong magnetic force has to be exerted out for re-charging. In the usual form of unlocking machine the current for the magnetic mechanism is usually applied until a certain batch of lamps is unlocked, when perhaps the current is still left on. This leads to waste of current and occasionally to damage to the lamps.

Making Gas Cylinders Safe.

For a large number of engineering and mechanical processes it is necessary to store oxygen in both its liquid and gaseous forms in cylinders. Especially for mine rescue work there is a great demand for reliable cylinders of much lighter types than are usually available. Accordingly the British department of Scientific and Industrial Research appointed a Committee to go into this question. This Committee has issued its first report dealing with the storage of air, oxygen, nitrogen and other permanent gases. The report includes a number of recommendations both to the composition and form of the cylinders and as to the rigorous tests which should be carried out before a cylinder is put into service. Recommendations are also made for periodical tests of the cylinders under hydraulic power.

A New Shop Window Publicity Device.

Endless ingenuity has expended in designing small appliances for producing moving advertisements suitable for shop window and similar places. One of the latest produced in Great Britain has the double of originality and simplicity. The essential feature of the device is a celluloid disc on which are printed nearly 50 small pictures. These pictures can, by an extremely clever device be printed direct from kinematograph film. When the machine is operated the pictures are flung on a screen and give in a few seconds the full effect of an ordinary film picture. Alternatively, the instrument can show a series of detached pictures each remaining on the screen for about three seconds. The operation is entirely automatic and silent. A wide field of usefulness for this invention is likely to be released.

More Light on Power Alcohol.

The possibility of securing an abundant source of alcohol for power purposes affords a question which deeply concerns many regions of the world. The British Department of Scientific and Industrial Research is continuing investigations of this important problem. A special officer was appointed to collect data from different parts of the world as to the possibility of producing alcohol in bulk from local vegetable materials. The actual building up of alcohol from various substances such as calcium carbide has also been carefully studied. At present the results attained are not altogether promising; and the British authorities consider that the best prospect lies in involving a process, either mechanical or bacteriological, of producing alcohol commercially from tropical vegetation or waste vegetable materials.

An Ingenious Flexible Coupling

One of the most common problems before the mechanical engineer is to provide an efficient and reliable flexible coupling between two shafts. There is no limit to the number of devices which for several generations have been designed to meet this demand; but a recent invention put on the market by a British firm provides that the field was not quite exhausted.
