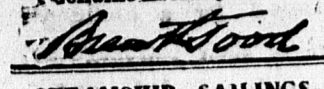

For the Children OWES HER HEALTH

Pu Yi, the Infant Emperor of China.



Young folks who read the newspapers are aware that the people of China have arisen against their Manchu rulers and demanded more freedom. In response to their demands an imperial edict has been issued granting a constitutional government, which means that the common people will have a part in making the laws for the government of the empire. Heretofore they have been ruled by the nobles. The imperial edict was ostensibly from the hand of the infant emperor, Pu Yi, or Hsuan Tung, as he is variously called. It says in part: "I have reigned three years and have always acted conscientiously in the interests of the people. But I have not employed men properly, as I am without political skill. I have employed too many nobles in political positions, which contravenes constitutionalism." The little emperor was born Feb. 11, 1906, and will therefore be six years old next February—surely a very little boy to rule so vast a country as China. But he is only a nominal ruler, the real one being his father, Prince Chun, who governs under the title of regent. Emperor Pu Yi succeeded to the throne Nov. 14, 1908.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within one mile of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$20 per acre.

Duties.—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each six-year period from date of homestead entry, including the time required to earn homestead patent and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$20 per acre.—Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.
