When Father and Mother told Johnny and Mamie that when they were 15 and 17 they preferred to spend their evenings with their dear parents, reading an improving book, to stepping out to a place of amusement, they are not telling the truth...

are waging their never-ending struggle with them. The only difference is that in Grandpa's and Grandpa's day the parents had the upper hand in the fight and now the children have it. For in the days when the heavy father really reared his children, he let him crumple out all the joy of life for them until they were old enough to run away from home...

But now that is all changed. Parents lost the war when they could no longer hold the threat of turning their children out of house and home over them, because there is nothing nowadays that the youngsters want so much as a good excuse for getting out on their own and being free of family discipline.

COOK'S CORNER HOUSEHOLD SCRAPBOOK

BAKED STUFFED SPARERIBS

2 sections spare ribs 1 cup chopped cooked prunes 2 cups soft cream 1/4 cup chopped celery 1 small onion, minced 3 tablespoons melted butter 1 teaspoon salt Dash of pepper 1 tablespoon onion juice

Method: Mix together the chopped prunes, the bread crumbs, celery and minced onion. Add the melted butter, season with salt and pepper, then add the lemon juice. Cover the top of one section of the spare ribs with the dressing and then place the other section over this. Securely with string or fasten with skewers. Place on a rack in an open roasting pan, basting in a moderate oven (325 deg. F.) for about 30 minutes per pound.

Run pillow cases seam first through a washing machine wringer and you'll save the force of water from tearing out the seam and make the cases last longer.

When sewing buttons on boys clothing, sew a piece of tape on the underside of the material and it will not loosen so quickly.

Discarded 12 1/2 stockings, or 12 or rayon stockings, make excellent dust cloths when several of them are padded together.
