At the end of that time he will take another trip to Halifax before returning to continue his studies in Queen's University.

The Supreme Court is still in session at Georgetown with Mr. Justice Hodgson presiding without a jury. The evidence in the case of Flynn vs Flynn, which commenced Monday, July twenty-ninth, has all taken on Wednesday evening and arguments were to have been heard yesterday, but at the suggestion of the judge which was readily accepted by the court, the arguments stand over until the thirteenth of September at Charlottetown. The case of Morrisey and Os, vs. McCormack, action of trespass, is now before the Court.

At the Police Court this morning it is expected there will be an investigation into further charges of forgery preferred against E. O. Brown. Some days ago the prisoner's office desk was opened before being sealed and the authorities became possessed of papers and documents therein. The new charges are said to refer to some four cases of alleged forgery of the name of W. C. White, as Registrar, certificates endorsed on deeds and mortgages and also some five or more cases of the alleged forgery of names of private persons on deeds and mortgages. The latter are understood to include the names of Thomas Campbell, Warren B. Vessey, Richard Vessey, and Milton Vessey, and the several transactions involve thousands of dollars. There is very great interest in the case.
