Asylum Granted Alleged Vichy Collaborators

OTTAWA, Oct. 17 — (CP) — An atmosphere of mystery and uncertainty tonight beset the story of four Frenchmen who have been granted special Cabinet permission to live in Canada despite charges that they collaborated with the Nazi-dominated government of wartime Vichy France. In the time that has elapsed since a well-informed government source disclosed that the four were granted asylum by order-in-council, these developments emerged: 1. Resources Minister MacKinnon, who approved the application of the four men for Canadian residence, in an interview branded the collaboration charge as false with the statement that he was "certain there was nothing to it." In this judgement, after inquiry, they were "fit and proper" persons to live in Canada. 2. Montreal, immigration authorities said the police records of the four were flown from France. The records were said to contain definite charges against them, backed up by sworn statements given the French police by members of the wartime Maquis. The immigration officials added that the men had admitted to them that they had entered Canada on false passports. 3. at Quebec, a staff member of Laval University said Dr. Georges Montel, one of the four, is lecturing there on medicine, though not a member of the faculty; the University authorities are believed to be familiar with Dr. Montel's background. The four were identified here as Dr. Montel, Dr. Andre Charles Emmanue Bouasat, travelling representative for a pharmaceutical company, Julien Gaudens Lebadan, former student of furniture design in France, and now reported to be working for a Montreal furniture firm, and Jean Louis Ruc. None of the four has commented on the charges or the background of his entry into this country. All are said to be living in Quebec Province. The government source here, disclosing their entry, said last night they would have been deported but for strong Quebec intercession which resulted in a special order-in-council granting them permission to take up Canadian residence. They were reported to be four of six alleged Vichy collaborators who entered the country while the French Government apparently was convicting them in absentia on collaboration charges. One of the six, it is said, was deported while the other was identified as Count Jacques de Bernonville, now fighting a deportation order before the courts in Montreal. I'm certain there's nothing to that charge."
