Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

The sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

NOTICE

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months on each of three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect house worth \$500.

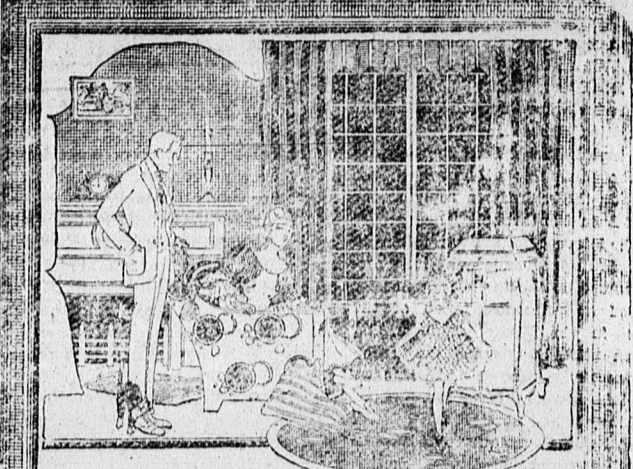
