**SIX BOSTON GIRLS SAVED FROM FIRE**

BOSTON, Sept. 22.—Six girls trapped by smoke which filled the hallway in a fire in a five-story building at Friend and to safety by police officers.

The fire started on the top floor, used for furniture and mattress storage by Charles B. Winroof, causing damage estimated at \$50,000. Dense smoke filled the building and poured out of the windows, enveloping the North Union station directly opposite.

Street traffic and trolley car traffic on the viaduct to Cambridge and Somerville were suspended for a time.

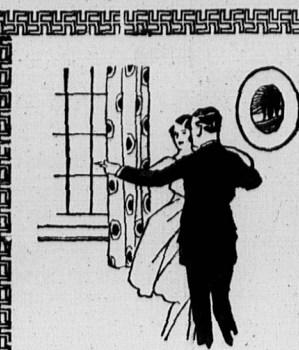

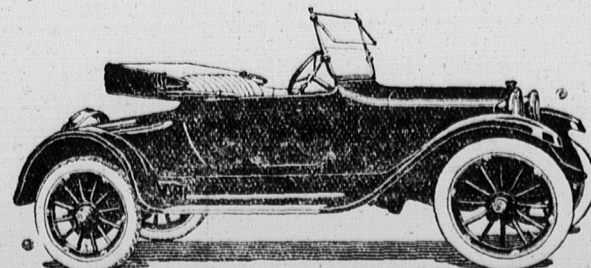
