Montreal "Star" April 17th, 1906. The first concert of a series to be given by the Turner-Weaver-Blair trio throughout eastern Canada and Newfoundland took place last evening at the Association Hall. The audience was large and the hearty applause bestowed upon each selection showed that the program, which consisted of piano, violin and vocal solos, readings and recitations was thoroughly enjoyed. The concert opened with a piano solo, Chopin's Polonaise in A flat, op. 33, in the interpretation of which Miss Dollie Blair made a good impression, which was heightened by her rendition of Liszt's Rhapsodie Hongroise No. 12. Her touch execution was excellent and both number were received with well deserved applause. Miss Irene Weaver, who has naturally a rich contralto voice, contributed two songs in a particularly pleasing manner.
