CANADA LED.

OTTAWA, Ont., Feb. 3.—According to statistics prepared by the British Board of Trade, Canada is the only country where immigration during the past year shows an increase over that of 1897. Its gain was twenty per cent., while all other countries show a falling off from one to ten per cent. These official returns include people of all nationalities sailing from ports in the United Kingdom, those destined for Canada including 17,665 persons of persons of British origin and 8,888 foreigners. This, of course, does not include the Doukhobors, who left from the Batoum direct.
