The Pan-Anglican Conference in London to commence next week will be the greatest gathering ever held by the Anglican Church.

The following are some of the chief problems that will be grappled with: The Sanctity of Marriage, The Drink Traffic, Gambling, Luxury, The Drink and Dividends, The Unemployed, Training for Holy Orders, The Relations between Local Churches and the Anglican Communion; Monopolies and Trusts; The Duty of the Clergy to Society Reform; Christian Science; Dramatic Literature; Journalism; Ministry and Laymen; Reality and Inspiration; Christianity and Socialism; These and many other questions will be handled at sectional meetings, such as those adopted by the British Association.

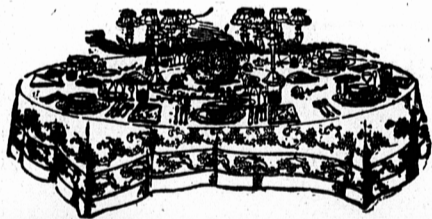
