In referring to the sending of mails by the Capes route, an exchange says:—An arrangement has been made with the New Brunswick and P. E. I. Railway to carry the mails to the Cape, and in addition teams will be used to forward later mails arriving by the Montreal and Boston express. He leaves to mourn seven sons and six daughters. The interment took place at Mount Buchanan cemetery, on Monday, the 4th inst., the body being followed to its last resting place by a large number of people from different sections of the country.

**EASTERN NOTES.**—February has been keeping up its usual reputation for wind and bluster while the trees have been coated with ice for an unusually long period, which will prove disastrous to many fruit and shade trees. Some nineteen years ago we had a similar experience the marks of which are plainly visible in the woods yet till this day. 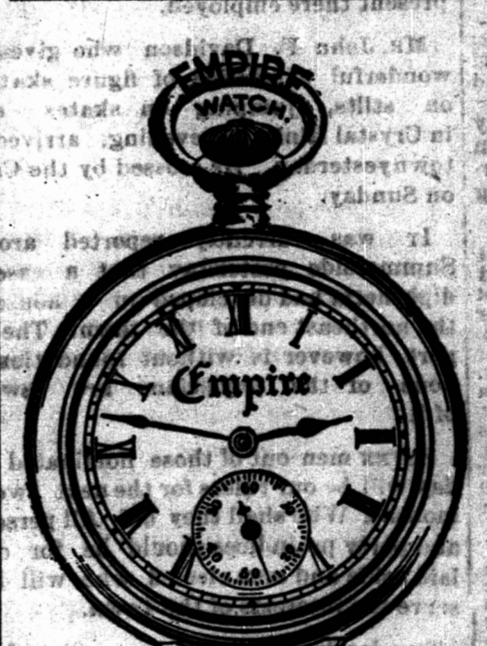
