SCHOOL INSPECTION
BY F. F. SMITH

F. F. Smith continued his work with the school inspectors Saturday morning by a discussion of the way in which a plant gets its nutriment from the soil. The materials must be dissolved in the water present in the soil, and as soil water usually contains only a very small percent of this material much water must be absorbed. Particular attention was called to the delicacy of the root hairs by which absorption takes place. Great care is needed in transplanting to prevent injury to them by rough handling or by being allowed to dry up. The effect of watering on development of new root hairs was also taken up. Injudicious watering may cause a surface development of rootlets, which may be injured by cultivation of the soil, or will be surrounded by dry soil if watering is not kept up. A good development of absorptive rootlets deep in the moisture soil is far more desirable.

Smith gave a talk on fertilizing principles in the soil. The most essential are nitrogen, compounds, phosphates and potash. All of these are desirable, and are found in most fertilizers, but they have somewhat different uses to the plant. Nitrogen compounds give vigorous growth of the green, growing parts, the others produce greater development of seeds and underground parts, as tubers and roots. Nitrates are derived from a great variety of sources, such as plant or animal refuse, and from the "Chili" salt petre dug up from the soil in South America. Some forms are much more readily available as good for plants than others thus dried blood is far superior in this respect to some products which resist decay, and so give up their nitrogen contents more slowly. A more full treatment of nitrogenous materials was reserved for a later lecture.

Phosphates are mainly derived from bones, from the phosphate rock of South Carolina or Florida, from the apatite, mined in Quebec and Ontario and from waste products of some steel works, "basic slag" or "Thomas Slag." These phosphates are generally insoluble as originally obtained, and so are usually made partially soluble by treatment with sulphuric acid. They are eventually available for use by plants in any case, but are much more readily available if made soluble before being put in the ground.

Potash compounds are well known to occur in the wood ashes, but are also obtained in great quantities from deposits in the earth. The deposits in Germany are most used at present.
