Verse 8-10—Sometimes with one single act a man contracts an incurable disease, and it results in his death; is there anything in such a circumstance to make a wise onlooker angry with God?

Did David act with wisdom or otherwise in being displeased with God for his destruction of Uzzah?

When we see or hear of great natural calamities, such as earthquakes, tornadoes, fires, etc., with great destruction of life and property, what should our attitude be toward God?

Verse 11—Take a town rich in its manufactures, in its general trade, in its shipping advantages, with no churches; and a similar town with churches added. Compare the

two in all that goes to make life worth living, and state the results of your comparison.

Does God invariably bless the home and the community in which are to be found "the Ark of the Lord?"

Verse 12-16—What is invariably the result of building a church, starting a Sunday School, or organizing a Bible class, where there are none?

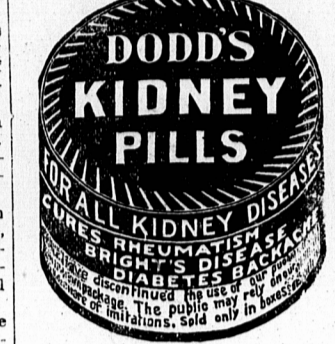

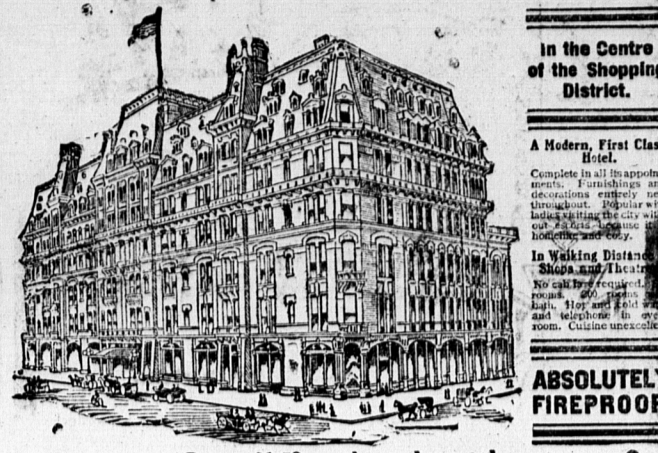
