## HAVE BEACONS UNDER WATER

### A Novel and Practical Channel Device — Lights on the Harbor Bed to Show the Way to Mariners

NEW YORK, April 11.—The question of harbor navigation by large vessels at night is a serious one at best. The usual lights designed to guide the vessel are too few and far between, and when they are obscured by fog the task of the pilot is a hopeless one and highly dangerous. Realizing the advantages to commerce of illuminating New York harbor so that it could be navigated at night, the lighthouse department has recently installed a series of buoys along the Ambrose Channel fitted with gas lamps, which serve as lamp-posts along the highway of the harbor. The lamps are provided with sufficient gas to keep them burning night and day for a month. They need no attention unless injured by collision with some vessel or by the force of the waves, says the Scientific American.

A new system of illuminating has recently been proposed, in which the lamps instead of being placed above water are situated along the bed of the channel, and are arranged to direct their light to the surface, where the outline of the channel may be traced by illumination of the water. By placing the lamps under water they furnish no obstruction to navigation of smaller vessels, which are not obliged to follow the deeper channels. They can also be placed low enough to clear the bottoms of the largest vessels as well.

A cable is laid along the channel, preferably one at each side of the channel, and at intervals along this cable the lights are attached. These consist of tubular buoys provided with a lens at the upper end and fitted with an incandescent electric lamp inside, the light of which is focused by the lens in a veritable shaft, which rises to the surface and illuminates a patch of the surface water. The lamps are supplied with current from a dynamo or battery on shore, where they are under the control of an operator. Following the usual custom, one side of the channel will be outlined with light of a different color from the opposite side. These lights could be placed at much more frequent intervals than the usual buoys.

However, experiments conducted by the inventor, Leon Dion, point to the fact that three or even two a mile would be ample in a straight channel. The cables can be securely anchored to the bottom, but the lamps, owing to their flexible connection with the cable, will be free to sway slightly with the motion of the water. The buoyancy of the lamps is merely sufficient to hold them upright and not strain the main cable.

The submerged lights would have an advantage over surface lights in serving as guides to submarine boats when manoeuvring in the harbor. In time of war the lights would be switched off under normal conditions, but whenever desired they could be turned on at a moment's notice to admit a friendly vessel.

## DIVORCE FASHION SAYS ARCHBISHOP

### War is Raged on Christian Marriages Says Mr. John Ireland.

ST. PAUL, April 11.—Archbishop John Ireland, of St. Paul, has written a letter to the clergy and laity of this archdiocese on the subject of marriage and divorce. The letter will be read in all the churches of the archdiocese tomorrow morning. Its occasion is the recent encyclical on marriage issued by Pope Pious X. The letter says in part:

"In the teaching of Christ the marriage contract is indissoluble. Human laws cannot dissolve it. The church, in its spiritual supremacy, cannot dissolve it.

"The cessation of the contract, the re-marriage to another of husband or of wife, renders fatherless or motherless the children of the first marriage, dissipate in their souls the sanctity of the home.

"Today, as never before war was made upon Christian marriages. The contract of marriage is stripped of all religious ceremonial, of all sacred meaning. It becomes a mere matter of hearts and fortunes, hastily entered into as the most insignificant of commercial exchanges, to be no less hastily burst asunder and forgotten.

"Divorce is almost the fashion, nations vie with one another in yielding up their statute books to decrees. Our own America leads in the race to do honor to its Empire. Our record in this regard as most shameful."

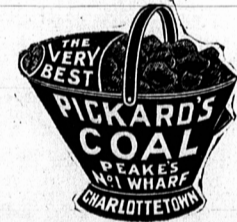
