The Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, June 27 - (AP)—Gains extending to around two points were scored by oats futures in fairly active trading today. Buying was based upon the strong upturn in cotton and news reports that a senate filibuster designed to block passage of office of price administration extension had got underway.

WINNIPEG, June 27 - (CP)—October and December eye advanced the full five-cent limit on the Winnipeg grain exchange today. There was no trading in July, which closed at five cents lower than yesterday.

NEW YORK, June 27 - (AP)—The stock market shifted to the rallying side today with notably "thin" issues pushing up to around 5 points at the best although there never was anything like a bidding rush.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was up 1 1/2 points at 78 1/2, best days recovery since May 28.

MONTREAL, June 27 - (CP)—Papers, industrials, banks, metals and liquors scored a smart upswing today on the stock exchange and curbs market. All the key groups moved up in the indices except utilities which were down. Papers jumped 14.18 and banks rose to a new all-time high. Volume expanded from recent low turnovers. Firms in New York and London and optimistic forecasts of possible taxations reductions in the Ottawa budget were factors in the upturn. Market analysts reported.

TORONTO, June 27 - (CP)—Influenced apparently by street predictions of tax reductions in the federal budget to come tonight, the Toronto stock market staged a sharp recovery in the final hour of trading today. The base metal stocks held gains of better than two points and the golds firmed 1.10. Western oils recorded a minor decline.

Shrewd investors have a feature of the base metal group. It traded 91,000 shares and closed at 3.05, up 17 cents net.
