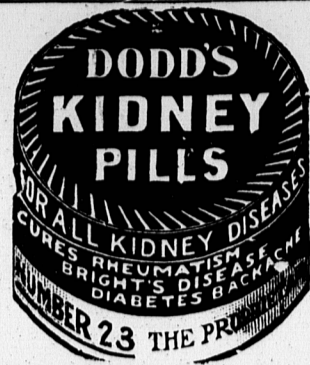
SUFFRAGETTE TACTICS ARE UNWISE.

A Liberal ministry in Britain seemed likely to be more easily convinced than a Conservative ministry that the women of the Kingdom desire and are fitted for the franchise on the same terms as men. It was known before the militant tactics of the Suffragettes began that many prominent members of the party now in power were very favorably disposed toward equal suffrage for men and women. This being so, it might have been supposed that the leaders in the movement for the enfranchisement of women would have chosen a conciliatory attitude toward the Liberal leaders. Strangely enough, quite the opposite course was pursued, and their cause has lost, for the time at least, the friends it had at the Speaker's right without gaining anything from the Opposition side.

AN OPEN LETTER TO SIR WILFRID.

Toronto Saturday Night, while independent in its attitude toward the political parties, has always had a warm corner in its heart for Sir Wilfrid Laurier. In the latest issue the editor of this very readable Toronto journal addresses an open letter to the Premier, the opening and closing sentences of which we here reproduce: "Dear Sir Wilfrid: For upward of thirteen years you have served Canada as its Chief Minister. For many years you served as Leader of His Majesty's Loyal Opposition. In all that period of time I do not know of one single imputation of wrong dealing—morally or politically—that could be rightfully brought home to you. CROMWELL DESCENDENTS. LONDON, Nov. 8.—The number of Oliver Cromwell's descendants at the present day affords a curious example of the persistence of English families, and their close intermarriages. Cromwell had nine children and thirty grandchildren, of whom more than one lived in the reign of George II. and the Ministry of Warpole. Among the Protector's lineal descendants today are, besides Lord Ripon, the Earls of Chichester, Roths, Morley and Clarendon and Lords Amthill, Avebury and Walsingham. The Earls of Darnley, Lathom and Lytton, Lord Glenesk and Sir William Harcourt all married Cromwell's descendants.
