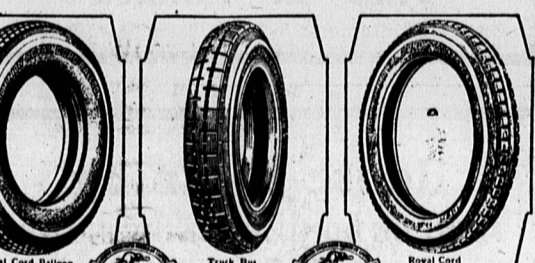


The Barbary Coast

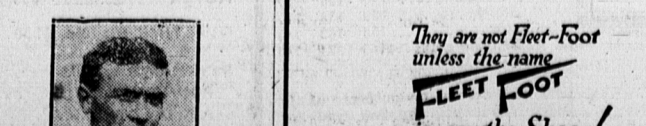

STOCK MARKETS

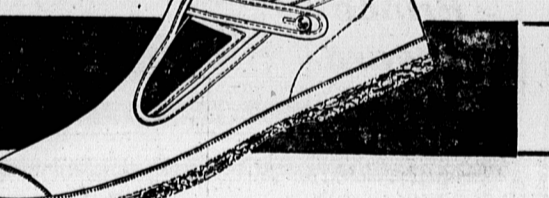
MONTREAL, Que., May 19.-Dominion livestock report. There were 96 cattle, 100 sheep and lambs, 705 hogs and 1553 calves, for sale on the markets this morning. The bulk of the cattle offered were cows of canner and cutter quality, with a few common bulls. Prices were unchanged at from \$2.00 to \$3.50 for cows and \$3.50 to \$4.50 for bulls. Good quality veal calves for \$7.50 and \$7.75 medium lots \$6.50 to \$7.00, and common fall fed calves for \$4.75 up. There were no real good calves offered today. Spring lambs sold from \$6.00 to \$9.75 each and sheep from \$5.00 to \$6.75. There was wide variation in prices paid for hogs this morning. On one market sales of mixed lots were made from \$13.50 to \$13.75 and on other from \$14.00 to \$14.50 was paid. Monday next, May 25th, the packing plants will be closed. Livestock exchange will observe holiday and it is expected there will be very little demand for live stock.
