Canada's 15th Parliament Was Dissolved Yesterday

\$150,000 FIRE IN CITY ON THURSDAY EVENING

Store Occupied by Prowse Bros., Ltd., is Badly Gutted and Heavy Loss Incurred—Firemen Have Hard Fight to Conquer Flames.

Damage to stock, to the extent of \$150,000 two thirds of which is covered by insurance, was done by the disastrous fire that broke out Thursday evening about six o'clock in Prowse Bros., dry goods establishment.

The outbreak was not noticed until the flames had made great headway, but the prompt arrival of the local fire brigade, after the alarm had been rung in by Mr. Nelson Gammam, no doubt saved the building from being completely destroyed.

GOVERNOR-GENERAL DISSOLVES PARLIAMENT ON THE ADVICE OF PREMIER MEIGHEN

Dramatic Ending to a Stormy Session—Dissolution Not Altogether Unexpected—Necessary Supply Has Not Been Voted But His Excellency Will No Doubt Authorize Further Appropriations—Meighen to Complete Cabinet.

OTTAWA, July 2.—Canada's Fifteenth Parliament has been dissolved. Premier Meighen today advised His Excellency to dissolve and the advice was accepted.

The stormy scenes of the last few days thus ended dramatically but not altogether unexpectedly although it was not anticipated that dissolution would come before the remaining business of the session had been disposed of.

At the same time considerable legislation goes by the board. This includes some legislation which has already passed both Houses but has not received the Royal Assent.

Other measures also go by the board. There is the Cameron Bill to empower grain growers to ship their grain to which terminal elevator they choose; the bill providing for the revaluation of soldier settlers lands; the resolution on the transfer of Alberta's natural resources; the bill to amend the Civil Service Superannuation Act of 1924 and the bill to authorize advances to settlers on crown lands.
